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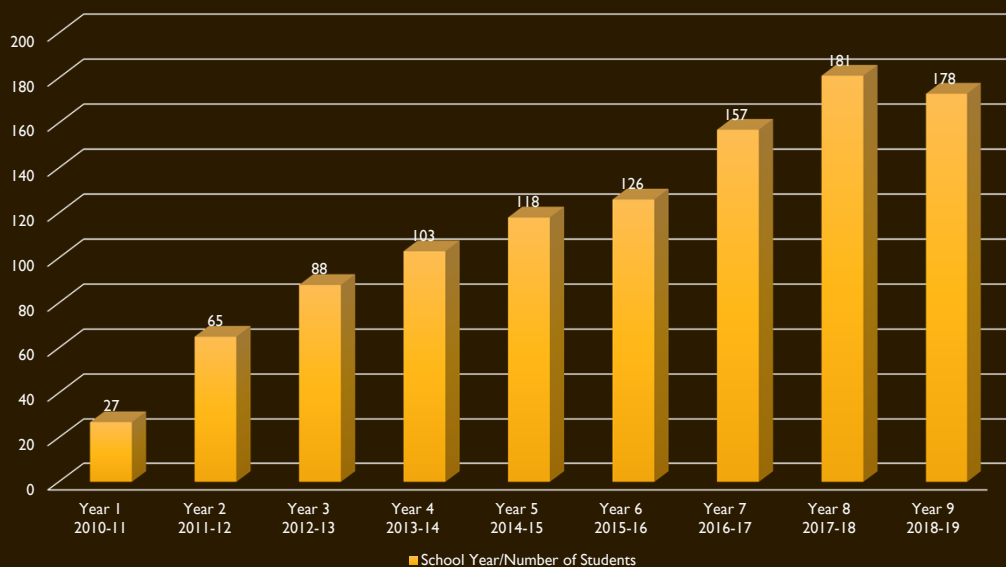

SUBJECT: INTERNET REIMBURSEMENT

The Allegheny Intermediate Unit will reimburse the families of 2018-2019 Waterfront Learning students utilizing program hardware for home internet access service charges, one per household, commencing with the student's effective enrollment date. The maximum reimbursement per family is up to \$35.00 per month and is payable quarterly. If your internet is a part of a package by your provider, you will be reimbursed for the portion of the bill that is for the internet service only not to exceed the \$35 limit.

The reimbursement schedule for the 2018-2019 school year is below. The Internet Reimbursement Form must be received by the due date to receive the quarterly reimbursement. Unfortunately, late submissions to Waterfront Learning will NOT be processed. Please allow at least 30 days from the deadline for process and reimbursement of payment.

### **How to schedule for classes at GHS**

- Scheduling can only occur on the website, NOT on the App
- Click the SCHEDULE tab on the left hand side
- Click REQUEST COURSES for 19-20 on top right side of screen, should be in blue bold type
- To ADD a course, highlight the course and click the ADD COURSE button. The course is transferred from the box on the left to the box on the right
- To REMOVE a course, highlight that course and click REMOVE COURSE.
- Once you have completed adding courses, add course alternatives. Click on REQUEST ALTERNATES in bold black type at top of page. Request 2 alternate courses.
- Only parents can remove a teacher recommended course
